Description: The Capitol Hill Appreciation Program is a new initiative by the Capitol Hill Community Council to thank and support those who make our community the great place that it is.

How long has this program been going on? We just started on April 22, 2025.

What does the Capitol Hill Appreciation Program (CHAP) do? The Capitol Hill Community Council drops off thank you cards to supporting businesses/locations. Then the public can come in and sign those cards. The CHCC will then pick up the cards a few days before they are due and send them where they need to go.

What will the CHCC do to support this project? The CHCC is looking at creating a website listing the locations one can go to sign cards/show support. We also hope to create a small poster if a business/location wants to put in their window.

How long of a commitment is this? Right now we are asking for two weeks of support. If you find this worthwhile (and it seems successful) we might continue it.
